## Mac users: Uninstalling the old Canasta Junction

To easily uninstall older Canasta Junction versions installed in macOS:

- 1. Run the **Finder** app by clicking on 🥲. You may also click on any empty area on your desktop
- 2. On the Finder menu at the top-left corner of your screen, select Go then Applications
- 3. Locate and select Canasta Junction in the applications list:

- 4. Select Canasta Junction (click once on it), then delete it by:
  - Holding the key  $\mathfrak{H}$  and pressing **delete** on your keyboard; or
  - Right-click Canasta Junction and select Move to Trash
- 5. If you're asked for a username and/or password, enter the credentials you use to log in to your Mac.

	2. Press and hold (or right-click) on the app, then select Uninstall
Uninstall in Settings $\rightarrow$	1. Select Start 📕 > Settings 🍄 > Apps > Apps & features 🚝
	2. Find the app you want to remove, select More > Uninstall.
